## **KNOW YOUR RIGHTS!**

### **WORKERS' COMPENSATION**

Are you SURE you know what to do if you are injured?

*Did you know:*

- Filling out an accident report does NOT mean you have started a Workers' Compensation claim.
- You have 30 days to notify your supervisor (not 24 hours as some supervisors would like to tell you) to report an injury.
- You do NOT have to lose time from work to have a Workers' Compensation claim.
- You can get mileage reimbursement to and from doctors' appointments, physical therapy, etc. if you have an established Workers' Compensation claim.
- You can go to any doctor for treatment who accepts Workers' Compensation.
